



Procedure F1 Tarmac Series 2026

January 2026

At the start of the Dutch Stock Car F1 season, the initiators of the F1 Tarmac Series, in cooperation with the promoters of **Raceway Venray** and **NOV Lelystad**, determine which events will count towards the F1 Tarmac Series. In 2026, the F1 Tarmac Series will be contested in Lelystad and Venray.

1. Drivers competing in the Stock Car F1 formula can score points for the F1 Tarmac Series 2026 standings. The following events count towards this championship:
 - 19 April 2026 – NOV Lelystad
 - 17 May 2026 – NOV Lelystad
 - 13 September 2026 – Raceway Venray
 - 25 October 2026 – Raceway Venray (*End-of-day final – double points*)The prize-giving ceremony alternates annually between Venray and Lelystad. In 2026, the presentation of the Silver Roof will take place on 25 October in Venray.
2. Prizes must be collected in person by the prize winners. If a driver is unable to attend, they must appoint a representative themselves and notify the F1 Tarmac Series organization at least one week prior to the prize-giving ceremony. If a prize is not collected by either the driver or their appointed representative, the prize will lapse and any monetary prize will be added to the prize fund of the following year.
3. The F1 Tarmac Series Champion is required to carry the Silver Roof, including any F1 Tarmac Series sponsors (logos supplied by the organization), for the entire following season in the Netherlands. If the champion refuses to do so, they will be excluded from participation in the championship the following year.
4. Points system:
 - Heats:
15, 14, 13, 12, 11, 10, 9, 8, 7, 6, 5, 4, 3, 2, 1
All drivers who finish the race get 1 point.
 - Finals:
25, 23, 22, 21, 20, 19, 18, 17, 16, 15, 14, 13, 12, 11, 10, 9, 8, 7, 6, 5, 4, 3, 2, 1
All drivers who finish the race get 1 point.
5. During all events counting towards the F1 Tarmac Series, the BVSr technical regulations apply. The first 3 finishers in each heat and the first 5 finishers in the final will be inspected and weighed. Cars may also be weighed on a random basis. If weather conditions are poor, race control may decide, in consultation with the head scrutineer, not to carry out weighing.
6. All participating promoters will provide weighing scales for each event counting towards the F1 Tarmac Series and will have reserve scales available.

If, due to circumstances, weighing cannot take place for the entire day, it will be decided in consultation with the BVSR and the promoter whether the event may count towards the F1 Tarmac Series.

7. The driver with the highest number of points at the end of the final event is the F1 Tarmac Series Champion and will carry the Silver Roof throughout the entire following season (until the next F1 Tarmac Series prize-giving). The top five drivers in the standings will receive prizes.
8. If two or more drivers are tied on points after the final race day, the total number of points scored in the day final on the last event day of the F1 Tarmac Series will be decisive.
9. Any Stock Car F1 driver wishing to participate in the F1 Tarmac Series must hold a valid BVSR or BriSCA license.
10. All F1 Tarmac Series prize winners will receive a personal invitation to the prize-giving ceremony. Prizes must be collected in person during the ceremony or by a representative previously notified to the organization.
11. All sponsors and participating promoters will receive a personal invitation to the prize-giving ceremony.
12. The initiators of the F1 Tarmac Series 2026 reserve the right to update the contents of this procedure at any time if circumstances require.
